

Results of Emergency Monitoring Examination (Fukushima Prefecture/Raw Milk)

Results from survey assured that raw milk was not shipped from the relevant farm after the earthquake.

The prefectural government would continue the examinations as well as the requests to farms in Kawamata town including the relevant farm that they would not ship and consume it for themselves for the time being.

All farm products in the area requiring evacuation and indoor evacuation are urged not to ship and self-consume.

Emergency monitoring examination for vegetables and raw milk in the prefecture has operated. Upon the analysis from it and with consultation with the national nuclear emergency response headquarters, essential measures would be taken.
