6. The internet is a convenient way to increase communication, but at the same time, there are more acts of misuse on the internet. What do you think about human rights violations on the internet?
7. The use of the internet by children and teenagers is increasing. How would you advise them on using the Internet?
8. Do you know what SDGs (Sustainable Development Goals) are? Do you know how many goals there are?
9. The SDGs Goal #4 is to "ensure inclusive and equitable quality education and promote lifelong learning opportunities for all." What initiatives would you like to see to provide quality education?
10. There are children all over the world who do not have access to an adequate education. What do you think will happen if they do not get enough education? What is the benefit of quality education?
11. The SDGs goal #5 is to "achieve gender equality and empower all women and girls." Do you know any examples of gender inequality around you?
